

Study Abroad in Germany: Social Work from an international Perspective

Study one semester Social Work at three Universities of Applied Sciences in two cities next to Frankfurt am Main – one of Europe’s most important airports: **Darmstadt** and **Mainz**. The cities are only 40 km apart and connected by an excellent public transportation system: one-way only 30 minutes.

The annually changing study program “Social Work from an international Perspective” offers the most interesting lectures and courses of the collaborating institutions – held in English. International students have the opportunity to learn about Social Work in Germany, its social institutions, laws and working reality, and reflect in an international study group on transnational and international aspects of Social Work. Social Work in Germany is very diverse: from kindergarten to working with the elderly; from education to administration.

In addition to the regular lectures and courses with German and international students, the program includes a German language course and the opportunity to reflect on the experiences during a colloquium.

This offer is available for students of Erasmus+ partner institutions of Mainz Catholic University of Applied Sciences and Darmstadt Protestant University of Applied Sciences.

The course catalogues are available from July 15th for the winter term and from February 1st for the summer term.
